Compadres Senior Center

Compadres offers seniors 55 years and older, an opportunity to get out of their homes and take part in new and interesting activities. This integrated program includes people who have had disabling conditions since their youth as well as those who are simply losing some of their abilities as they age. Compadres features activities proven to help seniors maintain their mental and physical abilities including gardening, fine arts, and fitness. Computers and games are also part of the program. Staff members can assist with personal care, and medication assistance and some nursing services are available. The program supports elders Monday through Friday so they can continue to live with family. People may attend full-time, part time, or as-needed. Unlike most assisted living services, there are no initial entry fees and the hourly rate is very cost-effective even for private pay.

Volunteer Opportunities

Adelante believes everyone can give back to the community and one of the agency's guiding visions is to help people with disabilities demonstrate their capabilities and value through community service. Adelante supports volunteerism through many of the agency's programs and via the following efforts:

Desert Harvest Food Rescue

A great opportunity for people with disabilities to give back to the community and be part of the solution to one of New Mexico's most persistent social problems – hunger. Desert Harvest rescues over 127,000 pounds of surplus prepared food monthly from restaurants in the Albuquerque metro area and Valencia County, and delivers it to other nonprofit agencies in New Mexico. 505.341.7186

With a focus on the individual and quality care, Adelante offers a wide variety of employment opportunities, life skills training, volunteer opportunities, vocational training, and residential support options for people with disabilities. We also offer several senior service options. Our well-trained, caring staff members are screened and background checked.

Adelante Supports People With:

- Physical disabilities including visual impairments, developmental disabilities, TBI, and orthopedic impairments
- Autism or who are on the autism spectrum
- Mental illnesses such as schizophrenia, bi-polar disorder, depression, and/or SDMI
- PTSD including disabled veterans
- Dementia, Alzheimer's, and other conditions that may be a result of aging
- Disadvantaged people who need access to various community resources.

Founded in 1978, the agency's programs extend across New Mexico. Adelante means "forward" in Spanish, reflecting a focus on helping people push past stereotypes and move forward in their lives. The agency promotes independence and individualized goals in all of the programs.

Learning in the Community

Adelante provides day programs in several New Mexico counties that offer life skills training and the opportunity for community service.

Employment Opportunities

Many people with disabilities have a goal of finding and maintaining employment. **Adelante's preference and primary focus is on finding competitive employment in the community** through EmployAbility (an employment search and support service) or via Social Security Ticket to Work. Adelante also offers vocational training and employment through the agency's own social enterprises.

EmployAbility: Employment Services

EmployAbility functions as an employment agency for people with disabilities providing job coaching, resumes, and assistance with job searches. Ticket to Work

Adelante is an Employment Network for the Social Security Ticket to Work program. A business handling high-security shredding of paper and electronic media for local businesses. This enterprise also can destroy hard-drives and recycle x-rays.

Adelante Facilities Support Services (FSS)

A business providing total facilities management, janitorial and maintenance services for businesses and government entities statewide including Kirtland Air Force Base. FLETC Contract

Adelante operates the dormitories at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in Artesia, New Mexico. The center provides work for people with disabilities including front desk/check-in, housekeeping, janitorial, and laundry services.

One of the largest bulk mailing operations in central New Mexico, this business processes over 250,000 pieces of mail per month. The Mailing and Fulfillment Center also provides custom packaging services for national, regional, and local businesses including shrinkwrap, heat sealing, poly-bagging and fulfillment.

Community Living

Adelante's Community Living programs offer a variety of levels of care to meet the needs of each individual. Supported Living, Independent Living, and Family Living services are available, and home ownership is also an option. In each area of Adelante's Community Living division, the goal is to allow people to live their lives to the fullest and to be as much a part of the community as they choose. Services are offered in Valencia County and in the Albuquerque metro area.

Family Living Services (Home-Based)

Adelante supports people with disabilities who live with their families, providing training to the caregivers, quality checks, and support for the individual.



Independent Living

Through Adelante's Independent Living program, people live in their own apartments or homes, alone or with roommates, and Adelante staff members check in on a scheduled basis to support them. Independent Living provides the greatest amount of freedom and community interaction of any of the agency's residential programs. Participants receive support to do their banking and cleaning. They also take part in social activities and receive training on many of the life skills needed to live in the community successfully.

Supported Living (24/7 Care)

Adelante operates over 20 homes in Albuquerque and Valencia County. Some are owned by the agency, some are owned by the residents, but all of them provide a completely accessible environment with supportive staff members. Nursing, nutritional counseling, and financial training are provided, with round-the-clock care available. The program can accommodate everyone from very active, on-the-go people to those who are medically fragile, but still want the opportunity to live and socialize in the community.

Adelante Back in Use

Adelante Back in Use connects people with disabilities and seniors to assistive equipment and computers they may not be able to afford. Additionally, this program provides job opportunities for people with disabilities who help handle donations, and refurbish and re-purpose computer equipment.



Members of the public can donate wheelchairs, walkers, hospital beds, scooters, working computers (less than five years old), or other medical or adaptive equipment they no longer use.

Benefits Connection Center

A free service helping New Mexicans of all ages connect to public assistance programs including Low Income Home Energy Assistance, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, Medicaid, Medicare Savings Programs, and Medicare Part D Low Income Subsidy. Adelante helps people find out what benefits they are eligible to receive with one easy process, then assists with enrollment or re-enrollment, as well.
